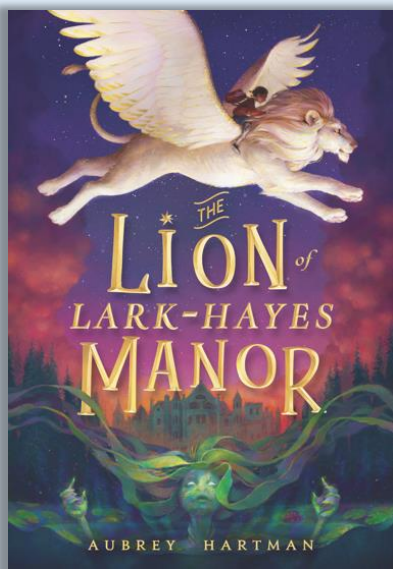
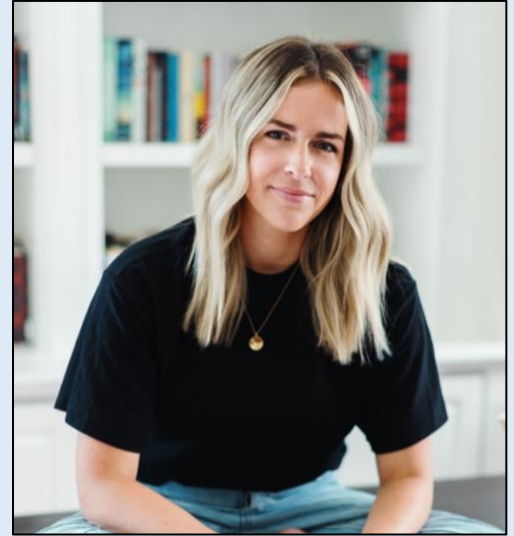


AUBREY HARTMAN

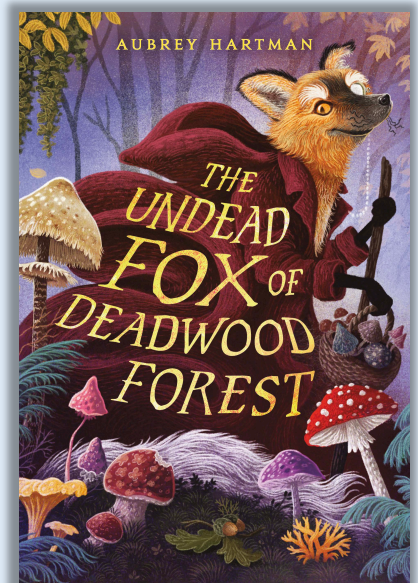

Presentations & Fees

- Option 1 -

For young readers

Hartman will share the process behind becoming an author and the obstacles she overcame in her journey using the 3 P's: Practice, Patience, & Persistence. The presentation concludes with a game of "What would you write?" in which Hartman shares select scenes from her books and has the children finish the dramatic action with their own creative ideas.

- Option 2 -

For young writers

Hartman will share the process behind becoming an author, her sources of inspiration, and how she found her voice as a writer. The goal of this presentation is to inspire children to see themselves as storytellers and realize the power of their unique individual voices. The presentation includes visuals, PowerPoint slides, and a short creative writing exercise.

This is a 20-minute presentation + 10-minute Q&A
